



Part List

Layout and count all parts as shown in the assembly diagram. Notify Customer Service immediately if any parts are missing or damage has occurred during shipment.






✓ Step-By-Step





Cage clip pliers are recommended for assembly.



1 *Unfold main panel assembly (A) so that it creates a "U" shape when standing upward.*




2 *Attach small shelf (B) to left side of cage using cage clips (G). Position long shelf (C) six inches higher on back panel than left side shelf. Position remaining small shelf on the right panel six inches higher than previous shelf.*



3 *Attach front/top panel (D) to main panel assembly using cage clips every four inches where the two panels meet.*




✓ Step-By-Step



4 Snap door guards (E) around edges of door opening.

5 Position cage so that it sits inside tray (F) once assembly is completed.



6 Use spring hook to attach cage to secure the tray during transport.
